If a defect is detected during production, the sheet can be rejected before it's ever released to a customer.

At GOEX, we are relentlessly pushing the boundaries of what's possible in extrusion. Our commitment to continuous product development is driven by a bold vision—to deliver high-performance, cutting-edge solutions that advance both our customers' needs and global sustainability goals. A hallmark of this innovation is our RE·COVER® Program, launched in 2020, which redefines material life cycles. Through strategic partnerships with our customers, we reclaim postprocess scrap and transform it into valuable materials for new applications—creating a truly closed-loop, responsible manufacturing model.
